

## Assignment #1: Introduction

(10 marks)

### **Task:**

You will be creating a simple hand-coded HTML page to introduce yourself (1<sup>st</sup> paragraph) and describe what you intend to learn in Web Design 12 (2<sup>nd</sup> paragraph). The HTML page should satisfy the following conditions:

- Code in a simple text editor. (Pass/Fail)
- Include a title called "HTML Assignment 1: Introduction" (1 mark)
- Include a large header in the first row of the body called "About Me". (1 mark)
- Write at least two well-written paragraphs. (2 marks)
  - 1<sup>st</sup> paragraph: Introduce yourself without confidential information.
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> paragraph: Describe what you intend to learn in this course.
- Link an external website that opens a new tab (or window). (2 marks)
- Have one image or graphic that is resized (either by shrinking or stretching) while keeping its original proportion. (2 marks)
- Use *emphasis (italicization)* or **strong emphasis (bold)** to stress on key words or phrases. (1 mark)
- Save the file as **index.html** (case sensitive) and upload to /yourname/html01. (1 mark)

Note 1: Do NOT use any deprecated HTML 4.01 tags and HTML 5 tags. See <http://w3schools.com/tags>.

Note 2: You will need to use Filezilla to upload **index.html** onto the web via FTP.

Note 3: You can check your work at <http://mrkam.ca/web12/yourname/html01>.

Note 4: You need to check your work on IE and Firefox/Chrome.

### **Evaluation: 10 marks**

- Up to 5 marks deducted for use of deprecated (e.g. <font>) and/or incomplete tags (e.g. missing closing tag to <p>)
