

## Assignment 3: Common HTML Tags


(20 marks)

### Prerequisites:

- Read the section on Intellectual Property (p.210) in *Introduction to Web Design using Dreamweaver*.

### Task:

You will be creating a hand-coded HTML table for storing definitions and examples of 15 most common HTML tags. The table should either be organized alphabetically or logically, and include a reference to w3schools (in APA format with hanging indent). For example,
